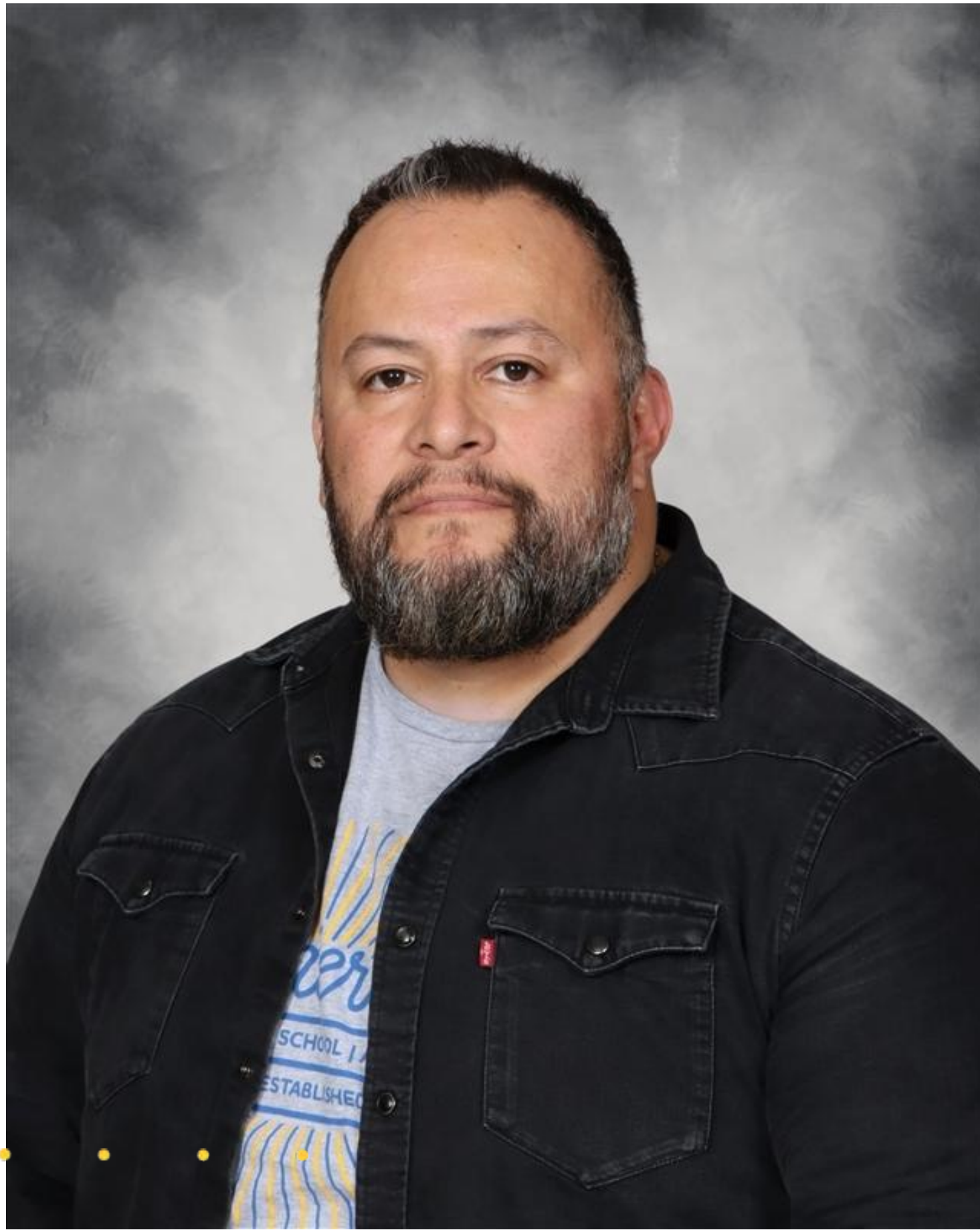

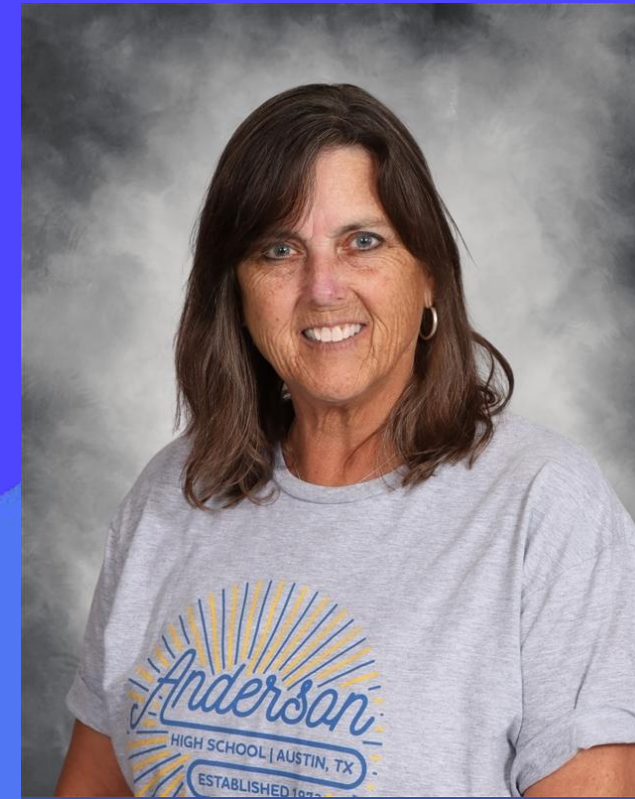

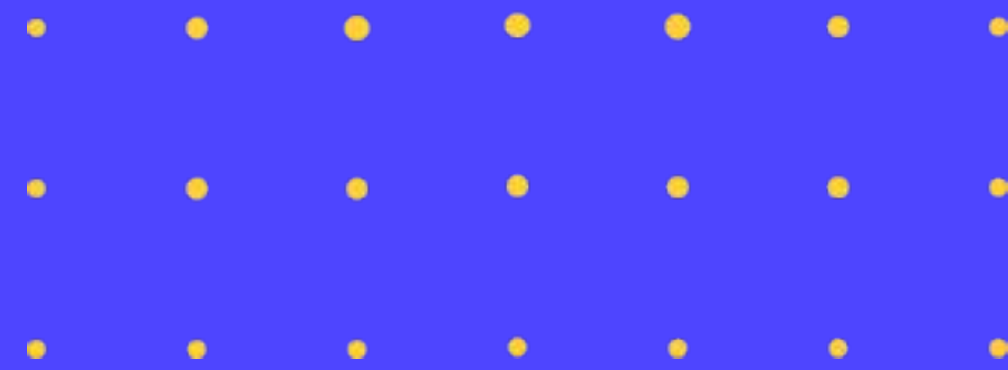

Three-Pronged Approach



"Ignite Learning": This phrase is active and positive, suggesting that effective instruction sparks engagement and deep understanding in students. It aligns with moving away from passive "computer time" or "free time."

"Impactful Instruction": This directly addresses the emphasis on high-leverage instructional practices and giving quality feedback. It highlights the quality and effect of teaching methods.

"For Every Student": This reinforces the idea that these instructional practices are designed to benefit all students and improve educational outcomes across the board.
