- ❖ **Approval of March 29, 2023 Minutes APPROVED** Cathryne McNamara
- ❖ **Student Concerns** (Please abide by 2 min rule.) Cathryne McNamara
 - Henry D. - Missing soap dispensers – and those present have no soap
 - Kelsey Lind - Girls history bathroom towel dispenser was refilled , but the knob to advance towels is missing so it doesn't work.
 - Amanda Kromer – stairwells get dirty after lunch with lunch items left in stairwell
- ❖ **CAC Member Concerns** (Please abide by 2 min rule.) Cathryne McNamara
 - Lauren Ward – still have concerns about drugs and vaping the bathrooms. Cost of vape detectors has decreased. Would encourage a search for solutions
 - Lauren Ward – concerns with coaches being territorial with their activity and would like to encourage sharing of students who do multiple activities
 - Tiffany Galligan PTSA Pres – cross walk concerns and safety issues on Mesa. Looking for solutions for crossing Mesa to Westover Church
 - Julie Joe – concerns about rat issue on campus
- ❖ **Principal's Report** Beth Newton
 - Principal Newton introduced guest Trustee Kathryn Chu who will speak on superintendent search and other items after the CAC meeting adjourns.
 - Anderson is only high school in AISD to have no negative fundings on the TEA Door and safety audit
 - Choice Sheets, Scheduling, Master Schedule,
 - Staffing, Hiring
 - Testing -TELPAS-finished (Shackelford), TSI-ongoing (Painter),
 - EOC (Lancaster) (Apr. 18, 26 and May 2 -tests in testing. Two days of testing for EOC has gone well so far – 1300 have been tested. Only 600 students need to be tested on May 2 for Algebra. So we will not have a campus shut down on May 2 and will perform EOC test under former displacement model, and help with needed accommodations
 - AP and IB (May) (Williams and Spencer) more than 1000 students taking 1400 exams. Need help from volunteers to proctor AP tests
 - Areas of Focus that administration and staff are working on for next year : Tardies, Bathrooms (Rules, Vaping, QR Codes), Badges, FIT, Lunch, Bell Schedule, Traffic patterns, ChatGPT,
 - UPDATES:
 - Rats, - building has been sealed so no new rats should enter. Still working on extermination
 - Vaping and bathrooms – will be purchasing vape detectors for next school year with a goal of deterrence along with Vape education. Will also be expanding drug prevention including drug dogs
 - Streets, Parking Lots, Crosswalk, Traffic Patterns – officials visited campus last week to observe and consider solutions. Suggested solutions were shared and discussed with CAC.
 - Panorama Survey and Principal Listening Sessions
 - Prom-May 6th@8pm, Baccalaureate-May 20th@3pm, Graduation-June 1st@7pm
 - Jesse Molina spoke regarding Graduation.
