- Testing-TELPAS-finished (Shackelford), TSI-ongoing (Painter),
 - 0 EOC (Lancaster) (Apr. 18, 26 and May 2-tests in testing. Two days of testing for EOC has gone well so far -1300 have been tested. Only 600 students need to be tested on May 2 for Algebra. So we will not have a campus shut down on May 2 and will perform EOC test under former displacement model., and help with needed accommodations
 - AP and IB (May) (Williams and Spencer) more than 1000 students taking 1400 exams. Need help 0 from volunteers to proctor AP tests
