The Practicum in Business Management is designed to be a capstone experience providing scholars with a supervised internship and the opportunity to apply the skills and principles learned in the Business Management Sequence. The program will help prepare scholars for entry-level employment and/or post-secondary education.

Summary of Requirements

- 1. Scholar must be 16 years of age or older (per TEA)
- 2. Completion of level I and II courses
- 3. Completed packet (MOU, essay, attachments, etc.)
- 4. Satisfactory Interview
- 5. Pass a Criminal Background Check
