Principal's Report Brian Lancaster

Budget Update

Hard Copy is available at the campus for anyone to see through Kellie Allen in the Anderson High School front office

This is not an official budget, this is what has been proposed and submitted – not available for distribution until it is fully approved by the Board of Trustees approve in May.

Staffing – Admins, Counselors, Teachers (got same allotment). Some positions will no longer exist – library clerks and delta TAs. Anderson will do some trades to align current needs of the school and current staff.

Discretionary Budget – no year to year changes same for 25-26 as 24-25

Programs Budget – Athletics, Fine Arts, AVID, CTE, IB, Speech & Debate. Extra funds can be allocated. We cannot make changes to what has been allocated to the campus. Dance got a boost for new uniforms this year. Soccer (girls & boys) also got a boost for new uniforms.

CCMR Budget – Based on student enrollment in CTE based on prior year - College Career Military Readiness – we use this budget for IB, College & Career, etc programs at Anderson. This budget it kept separate from other budgets.

Overall able to stay mostly the same at Anderson year to year which is good news

CIP Update

Objective #1 – CCMR from 82% to 90% - many ways to get this through dual credit, TSI, OnRamps, AP, IB, Industry Based Certifications (IBC), College Prep, IEP....

- 1.1 Monthly meeting with CTE teachers looking at doing IBCs earlier for Freshmen/Sophomore years so they don't run out of time in Junior/Senior years to earn them
- 1.2 Increase Opportunities for TSI Bootcamps

Objective #2 - Decrease 10.1% to 4.45% Disparity of African-American students in disciplinary actions

- 2.1 Increase Reliance on restorative practices

Objective #3 - Algebra 1 EOC increase in passing

- 3.3 MAPS as a tier 3 algebra intervention based on 8th grade grades
