

Anderson High School Cell Phone Campus Policy

Cell phones are banned during instructional time, including Homeroom and FIT.

Appropriate Cell Phone Guidelines:

- 1. Cell phones may be used before school, between classes, lunch period, and after school.
- 2. Cell phones may be used during organized after school activities with the teacher's/tutor's/coach's permission for approved purposes.

Inappropriate Cell Phone Examples:

- 1. Using cell phones in the classroom for any reason during instructional time, including homeroom and FIT, without the teacher's authorization.
- 2. Leaving the classroom during instructional time for a bathroom/water break and using a cell phone.
- 3. Using a cell phone to film/photograph students, teachers, school visitors, or staff without authorization.
- 4. Using a cell phone to cheat or to provide other students with notice of exam content or questions.
- 5. Using a cell phone to promote gossip, bullying, to escalate hostilities among students, or encourage fighting.
- 6. Using a cell phone to access or share inappropriate content.

First Offense in classroom: Teacher will confiscate and return at the end of the period.

Second Offense in the classroom: Teacher will confiscate and turn in to the main office. Student may retrieve at the end of the day.

Any device turned into the office two or more times will be subject to a \$15 fee.

***Students failing to comply with this policy may subject to additional disciplinary

consequences.***
